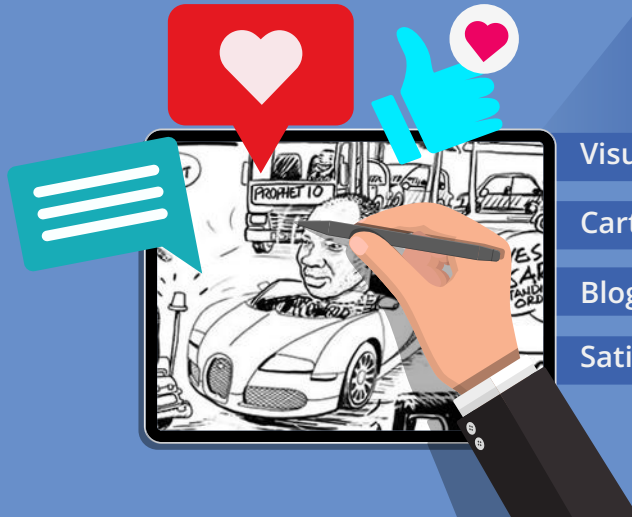


Calling Out Fakery Among Christian Religious Leaders in Ghana
